



## **COUNTERTOP INSTALLATION**

### **Preparation for Countertop Installation**

- Remove all drawers from all lower cabinet
- Empty all contents from all lower cabinets
- Have sink removed
  - Please ensure you have working hot and cold valves shut off or make arrangements with your Sales person for your installer to remove and/or install your sink and if needed to install shut offs.
- Please have clear access for Installers to bring in countertops into your home.

### **Precautions to be taken after new installations**

Your Installer will instruct you on some of the following precautions such as:

- Do not put anything heavy on the seams (if you have any) of your newly installed countertops for at least 48 hours. (ex: Microwave or coffee pots.) The weight or the heat will interfere with the glue drying.
- Keep water off seams and caulking for at least 24 hours
- A Stove at the incorrect height will damage the end caps of your new countertop.
  - The installer will explain the correct height if you are unsure

### ***PLEASE NOTE***

- Installers do their best to take care to remove and install without damage to paint or tiles. However, minor damage does occur unfortunately.
- Installation includes the cutting of ONE standard sink hole only. Faucet holes are not included in the installation.
